REALIZE THE TAX SAVINGS

You can set aside pre-tax money into an account to be reimbursed for eligible medical expenses. Savings will depend on your tax bracket. For example, if you are taxed at 25% and you enroll for a plan, you would save 25% in taxes.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW CAN I SUBMIT A CLAIM? You can submit a claim online through our website, by fax or mail, if you prefer. Please note that all claims must be submitted within 90 days of the date the expenses were incurred.

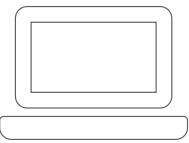
WHAT MUST BE INCLUDED ON RECEIPTS? All receipts for reimbursement must include the following information: date of service, provider name, patient name, amount of charge, and a description of the service.

WILL I HAVE A DEBIT CARD? Yes, you will have a debit card for your account. The card will be used to deduct your contributions from your bank account.

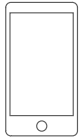
EACH YEAR? Yes, you will have a new debit card issued to you each year. The card will be valid for one year from the date of issuance.

WHEN WILL I HAVE ACCESS TO THE FUNDS IN MY HEALTH CARE FSA? You will have access to the funds in your Health Care FSA starting on the first day of the plan year.
